Mr. Freeman-Harrison said feedback from local citizens was helping him consolidate his view of what matters to the community he desires to represent.

“People have reached out to me saying they support my election issues and asking me for further details. One gentleman suggested a road should go through the middle of Hargreaves Mall. Another gentleman suggested that, whatever the plan, it should include how to get good tenants into the empty shops. Regarding CBD parking, I want to lower the daily cost for

workers in our community. Those who want free parking can easily park a couple of extra blocks away and walk further, which is good exercise.”

Mr. Freeman-Harrison is urging the community to continue supporting one another as we continue to battle through these unprecedented times.

“Some of us are going through the hardest period of our lives. We need to buy local, support local family businesses and encourage innovation and ideas. I am adaptable, and as our environment changes, we need councillors who are adaptable. I want to help our city pull through this pandemic and come out the other end, better and stronger than we were before”.
